I heard someone mention recently that they had gotten so busy after they retired that they were considering going back to work so that they could get some rest. It seems we are all too busy these days. Every year as June approaches, the combined crush of late May tasks, chores, meetings, concerts, recitals, holidays, and events leaves me longing for a few simple, unspoken hours. Something in every human understands the need for rest, even though too few of us take the time to engage in anything resembling leisure. Although church work isn't seasonal in the way that teaching school is, there is a certain summer lull to the overall schedule, so I greatly anticipate June with its warm, but not too hot, days and relaxed evenings.

Jesus once said, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath" (Mark 2:27). The leaders of the temple and synagogue had made the Sabbath requirements so egregiously hard that one almost looked forward to the day after the Sabbath so you could get some rest. Jesus took issue with this, pointing out that God had not needed a rest insomuch as He needed to model to humans the importance of taking a break. Like a good teacher, he hoped that his example (and commandment) would ensure that we learned the lesson.... which we did not.

Rest. Real rest that refreshes is hard for us. Too often we forget that if we are to be truly productive and accomplish great things, the first thing we need to be sure of is that we are not exhausted at the beginning. So, as the days lengthen, for some of us, that means more time for relaxation...unless you farm, then it means the very opposite. One way or another remember that taking time to actually rest isn't a character flaw...although in scripture, pride is considered a character flaw...a sin even. So, if you find yourself proud of your breakneck schedule that never leaves time for relaxation, maybe it's time to re-evaluate what you consider a virtue and what you consider a vice....and rest.

FINANCE - Brian Crum, Treasurer

Unfortunately, the financials from March and April have not been stellar. While our attendance was good through Lent, our revenue didn't match up. We are down 4.6% from the previous year. While we are out of our current fund, we have \$53,000 left in the contingency fund and another \$32,000 in undesignated memorial funds, so we still have a little in reserves. I am still waiting to hear back from the IRS on the amended payroll returns for the Employee Retention Credit.

The ABC side of things is still recovering from our transition. They have lost \$33,000 this year, but we have seen some improvements. We now have a full staff and are working to increase our enrollment. Please stop in and say hi to all of the wonderful people in the Center!
